<b>Regulations</b>	<p>The Tournament will be played in accordance with the Badminton Europe regulations as laid down in App. IX - European Senior Championships and the Laws and Regulations as adopted by the Badminton World Federation.</p> <p>Regulations <a href="#">CLICK HERE</a></p>

<b>Participation Fee</b>	<p>Player entered in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1 event: Euro 75, -</li> <li>• 2 events: Euro 90, -</li> <li>• 3 events: Euro 120, -</li> </ul> <p>The entry fees are payable after receipt of the invoice. Each Player will receive accreditation and a commemorative towel.</p>
<b>Entries</b>	<p>All 5 events will be played at the Championships in the following age groups: 35+/ 40+/ 45+/ 50+/ 55+/ 60+/ 65+/70+/75+/80+</p> <p>A player is eligible to compete, provided he or she fulfils the age requirement before 1 January of the year in which the Championships are played. (youngest players must be born in 1988 or earlier).</p> <p>A player is eligible to enter an event for players younger than the age group he or she qualifies to play in. He or she may, however, not play in the same event in more than one age group.</p> <p>Each Member shall be entitled to enter in each age group:</p>

8 players in men's singles

8 players in women's singles

A maximum of 16 players in each doubles event (men's doubles, women's doubles and mixed doubles).

A Member may enter a maximum of eight pairs comprising only their own players. However, a Member may enter a maximum of sixteen pairs comprising one of their players partnering a player from another Member, provided always that the total number of players from any Member does not exceed sixteen players in any event. Entries may be submitted only by a Member.

The minimum entry in each event will be 8 players/pairs. Any event not having an entry of 8 players/pairs may be put together with the age group below.

Each Member entering players shall, at least fourteen days before the start of the tournament, nominate their team manager/representative. (When a country only enters one player, that player will be accepted as team manager).

Partnerships will be made after the entry deadline by drawing lots amongst all players entered as "partner wanted".

### 3. Tournament Details

<b>Seeding Date</b>	Seeding shall be done by Badminton Europe who shall seek expert advice. The provisional seeding will be announced on 6 August 2024. The final seeding will be announced on 8 August 2024.
<b>Draw Date</b>	The draw will be conducted and published on <b>Friday 9 August 2024</b> .
<b>Shuttles</b>	YONEX AS-50.
<b>Practice</b>	An online practice booking form will be made available on the BEC event's website and should be done before <b>13 August 2024</b> .
<b>Stringing</b>	Badminton Europe's official event partner and equipment supplier, YONEX, will provide stringing service throughout the whole event.
<b>Team managers Meetings</b>	The Team Managers' Meeting will be held on <b>24 August 2024 at 17.00</b> at Holiday park Molenheide (Official accommodation). All participating Members must be present at the meeting.
<b>Technical Official briefing</b>	The Technical Official briefing will be held on <b>24 August 2024 at 20.00</b> hotel Soete Wey (T.O hotel)
<b>Medal ceremonies</b>	All medals will be presented on Saturday 31 August 2024 after all finals have concluded. All medalists are required to be present at the medal ceremonies.

<p><b>Accreditations</b></p>	<p>All info should be completed at <a href="http://www.esc2024.be">www.esc2024.be</a> → ACCREDITATION</p> <p>Accreditations will be issued at Park Molenheide and Hasselt, exact location TBC.</p> <p>Both players, coaches, supervisors, and anyone staying at Molenheide will receive accreditation.</p> <p>The deadline for accreditations requests is <b><u>25 July 2024</u></b>.</p>
<p><b>Clothing and advertising</b></p>	<p>Clothing and advertising will be permitted in accordance with the regulations for the European Senior Championships, regulations 11-12.</p> <p>Please note clothing must comply with existing BWF regulations, unless exceptions have been given by Badminton Europe.</p> <p>In order to ensure an attractive presentation of badminton, only acceptable badminton sports clothing will be permitted during play.</p> <p>A player who wears shoes that leave markings on a badminton court and is not willing or able to change to acceptable shoes, is not allowed to play his/her match. This will be decided by the Referee immediately before the start of the match and consequently the player will be disqualified for this event. The player can still play other events he/she entered.</p> <p>The name of the player and the name of the player's association on the back of the shirt are both optional.</p>

	<p>In applying regulations on clothing and designs and advertising on players' clothing the decision of the Referee shall be final.</p>
<p><b>Badminton Integrity</b></p>	<p>Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.</p> <p>To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.</p> <p>Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a match(es).</p> <p>For more information, please refer to BWF's website:  <a href="https://corporate.bwfbadminton.com/integrity/anti-match-fixing-overview/">https://corporate.bwfbadminton.com/integrity/anti-match-fixing-overview/</a></p>
<p><b>Doping control</b></p>	<p>Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.</p> <p>Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body.
